- □ 1. Complete the Application and Application fee \$50.00 (*NON-REFUNDABLE*);
- □ 2. Current Color Photo; 2x2 in. (Passport Quality);
- □ 3. Sponsor must hold an active NM Body Artist, Body Piercing-Scarification or Permanent Cosmetics license for a minimum of 5 years with NO disciplinary action;
- □ 4. Must work and identify a NM licensed establishment where training will take place;
- **5**. Proof of age, a photo copy of Driver's License is acceptable (**DO NOT SEND ORIGINALS**);
- \Box 6. Application must be signed and dated;
- \Box 7. Answer all questions to the best of your knowledge (if you answer yes to any questions, please give details on a separate sheet of paper include a certified copy of final judgment papers);
- □ 8. Completed the Jurisprudence examination, <u>MUST</u> pass with score of 75% or greater;
- 9. Apprentice must remain under the direct supervision of approved Sponsor until all requirements and training have been met;

UPON APPROVAL AND COMPLETION OF APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM:

□ 1. The sponsor will be required to record progress throughout the apprenticeship and will serve as proof of completion of the training program;

1 2. Upon completion of the apprenticeship training program, the sponsor shall submit the notarized log and statement to the board office within 30 days. (If program is not completed, the sponsor must submit the notarized statement with hours completed within 30 days).

□ 3. The sponsor must give a copy of the notarized log and statement to the apprentice.

4. Upon Completion of the apprenticeship training program, the apprentice will apply for licensure in the area of training.
