



NEW MEXICO FINANCIAL INSTITUTION HOLIDAYS – 2022

Financial institutions, notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 12-5-1 through 12-5-9 NMSA 1978, may observe the following legal holidays:

New Year's Day	Friday, December 31, 2021* Saturday, January 1, 2022*
Martin L. King, Jr. Day	Monday, January 17, 2022
President's Day	Monday, February 21, 2022 (FID Offices will be open this day)
Memorial Day	Monday, May 30, 2022
Juneteenth National Independence Day	Sunday, June 19, 2022* Monday, June 20, 2022*
Independence Day	Monday, July 4, 2022
Labor Day	Monday, September 5, 2022
Indigenous Peoples' Day	Monday, October 10, 2022
Armistice & Veteran's Day	Friday, November 11, 2022
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 24, 2022 (FID Offices are also closed on Friday)
Christmas Day	Sunday, December 25, 2022* Monday, December 26, 2022*
New Year's Day	Sunday, January 1, 2023* Monday, January 2, 2023*

Bank Holidays are established by Section 58-5-7 NMSA 1978, which states:

Nothing in this section shall be deemed to require a bank to close or cease operating any remote financial service unit installed pursuant to the Remote Financial Service Unit Act (§58-16-4 NMSA 1978) or any automated teller machines located on the bank premises during all or any part of a legal bank holiday.

*Whenever one of these bank holidays falls on a Sunday, the following Monday is a legal bank holiday. Whenever one of these bank holidays falls on a Saturday, that Saturday and the preceding Friday may be considered legal bank holidays (although the Federal Reserve Branches will be open on those Fridays).
