

Cannabis sales near \$38 million in June

SANTA FE—The Cannabis Control Division of the Regulation and Licensing Department on Tuesday announced that during the month of June, licensed retailers around the state sold nearly \$38 million in adult-use and medical cannabis combined. "One year ago, on June 29th, Governor Lujan Grisham signed legislation that created the Cannabis Regulation Act. As adult-use sales remain steady, this new industry is bringing new economic opportunities for entrepreneurs and communities across New Mexico" said Acting Director Carolina Barrera.

In June, adult-use cannabis again topped \$21 million.
