

Private Patrol Operations Manager License

CERTIFICATE OF EMPLOYMENT OR CONTRACT

Under the Private Investigations Act [Chapter 61, Article 27B NMSA 1978] a Private Patrol Operations Manager must be employed or under contract with the Private Patrol Company the applicant is being licensed to manage.

If the employment or contract for service terminates for any reason, the license of the Private Patrol Operations Manager <u>immediately terminates</u> and the manager must turn over the license to the Private Patrol Company.

The Private Patrol Company <u>is required</u> to notify the Regulation and Licensing Department within thirty (30) days from the date of termination and return the manager's license to the Department.
