Dental Therapist Collaborative Management Agreement

- 1. A dental therapist may practice only under the supervision and authorization of a dentist licensed New Mexico, and only through an online practice agreement signed by both the dentist and the dental therapist, and on file at the board office. A dental therapist may provide only the services outlined in this agreement, at the supervision levels detailed in this agreement. A dental therapist who provides services or procedures beyond those authorized in the written practice agreement engages in unprofessional conduct for the purposes of sections 16.5.65 and 16.5.66 NMAC.

The agreement shall be updated via the board template and on file with the board office. Electronic signatures are required.
- 13. A supervising dentist cannot supervise more than three dental therapists at one time during clinical hours.
- 14. Agree to dental therapy sections 16.5.60 through 16.5.66 NMAC.
