NMDA SEED LAW 76-10-13

- **Font size** used on a label shall be no smaller than 1/16 of an inch by measuring the height of a lower-case letter "o".
- **A label shall not contain**
 - Any untruthful or misleading statements including, but not limited to, health or benefit claims.
 - Advertising or marketing.
 - Contain words that refer to products that are commonly associated with minors or marketed by minors; including use of the word(s) "candy" or "candies" on the label of any container, *unless the words identify the strain of cannabis in the cannabis finished product.*
