



## Interpreter Intern or Student Registration

Per §61-34-5 NMSA 1978, the activities or services of a supervised interpreter intern or student in training who is enrolled in an interpreter education program, interpreter preparation program, or a program of study in signed language interpreting at an accredited institution of higher learning approved by the board are exempted from the requirement of holding a license issued by the Signed Language Interpreting Practices Board.

However, per 16.28.3.19 (B) NMAC, interpreter interns are required to contact the Signed Language Interpreting Practices Board Administrator at the beginning of their internship period and provide the information listed below.
