



When you bounce, safety counts!

**Is your bounce house or jumper certified safe?
Inquire before you hire.**

Bounce houses can bring a lot of joy. They can also be dangerous if mismanaged.

All bounce house and inflatable operators in New Mexico must have a certificate from the Carnival Ride Insurance Program. Rides without certification pose a safety risk to those who use them.

Those who operate unregistered inflatables may disregard safety by:

- Not having proper insurance to protect ride patrons in the event of an accident
- Ignoring yearly inspections that determine whether or not a ride is operating properly
- Operating in unsafe weather conditions like high wind or rain
- Not using the right safety equipment to keep inflatables in place

Your child's safety is important.

Before you hire a bounce house for your next event, ask the operator if they have a certificate of operation from the State of New Mexico Carnival Ride Insurance Program. Learn more:
