

TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL INSPECTION

LICENSING

- Post establishment license and individual licenses in a conspicuous area where they are visible to the public.
- Individual licenses must have a recent photo of the licensee. Must present ID with photo to inspector when requested.
- Post most recent inspection report in a conspicuous area where it is visible to the public.
- Students are only allowed to practice in any facility if the permit is current and not expired.

INFECTION CONTROL

- Establishment must be clean.
- If a sharps container is being used for razors or blades, a log of when and how they are being disposed of must be maintained. (NMDOH, clinics, fire department, hospital)
- Product and chemicals (disinfectant) not in original containers must be labeled (bottles, totes, and jars).
- Multi-use implements (drill bits, clippers, brushes, combs, nail clippers, tweezers, scissors) must be isolated and separated from contaminants and stored in enclosed containers labeled ready to use / not ready to use - clean (ready to use)/ dirty (not ready to use).
- Drawers with multi-use implements should be marked ready to use / not ready to use - clean (ready to use)/ dirty (not ready to use).
- Pedi logs must be maintained to identify when the tub is cleaned, which disinfectant was used to clean, and the licensed individual who cleaned the tub. The log entries must be maintained for 12 months.
- Single-use pedicure tub liners must be disposed of after each use.
- Single-use items (pedicure pads, emery boards, buffing blocks, toe separators, sandpaper drill bits, nail files, porous files, and porous buffers) shall be disposed of after each use.

OTHER ITEMS TO NOTE

- If a license is incorrect or missing information (no expiration, misspelling, etc.), please use the button below to schedule an appointment with board staff to get corrected as soon as possible.
- Inspectors will never ask for payment or money during an inspection.
- Inspectors will have identification badges when they enter any facility.

SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT NOW

PROHIBITED

- Alcohol/spirits located in the establishment.
- Pets in the establishment (a guest's or owner's) with no service animal identification.

APPROVED DISINFECTANT

- Medical grade disinfectant
- Disinfectant must be mixed properly
