



INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A REQUEST FOR INVESTIGATION

Thank you for contacting The New Mexico Regulation and Licensing Department's Construction Industries and Manufactured Housing Divisions regarding your request for investigation.

1. Fill out the form completely using **black ink**. Blue ink and pencil do not photocopy well. Additional pages may be attached if necessary.
2. When your request form is completely filled out, copy it and attach any documents necessary to explain or identify the transaction, including but not limited to the following: estimates, quotes, receipts, invoices, contracts, advertisements, bank records or canceled checks showing payment, emails, texts, etc. We recommend that you send copies instead of the originals. Please send photographs that identify areas of concern. Also note that all documents and other materials submitted to our office become the property of the State of New Mexico.
3. Email the completed form and accompanying documents to rld-cid-complaints@rld.nm.gov, or mail/hand-deliver to the CID/MHD offices located at 5500 San Antonio Dr. NE, Albuquerque, NM 87109. When we receive your completed request form and attachments, we will review the information to determine if your request falls within the jurisdiction of our agency. If we do not have jurisdiction, we will make every effort to refer your request to an agency that may be able to help you. For instance, the CID/MHD Division cannot handle requests of a financial or contractual dispute (unless a judgment is issued, CILA § 60-13-23). Some cities and counties have their own jurisdictions and you will be advised if your complaint occurred in one of those local jurisdictions.

If it is determined that our agency has jurisdiction, we will review your complaint to determine the appropriate action and assign it to an investigator. You will receive a letter informing you that an Investigation is open and an investigator will be assigned to your case. Once your case is open you become a witness for the state's investigation and the investigator may or may not contact you to collect further information. We will keep you informed as action items happen during the investigation. You may be required to testify in a hearing (for cases involving a licensed contractor) or magistrate/metropolitan court (for unlicensed contractors).

In all investigations, the individual or business being investigated will be informed of the allegations against them and will have access to all of the evidence provided in the complaint. The CID and MHD Divisions cannot act as a private attorneys, give you legal advice, or represent you individually in litigation in court. Consumer laws in New Mexico allow for the private and individual right of action and anyone can file a consumer claim in court. CID and MHD initiate legal action on behalf of the Commission/Committee only when there is a violation(s) of the licensing Act(s), code, and/or regulations. Investigations involving unlicensed contractors are prosecuted under CILA § 60-13-52 in the magistrate/metropolitan court in the jurisdiction where the unlicensed contracting occurred.

- Contractual or Financial Disputes (without Judgment- CID only)
- Manufactured Housing transportation (Public Regulation Commission <http://www.nmprc.state.nm.us/>)
- Paint, tile (and other flooring), fencing, and most landscaping as they are no longer regulated. Please note that retaining walls and walls, not fences, are still regulated.

If you are filing a complaint regarding a suspected state code violation (only applies to investigations on licensed contractors), please note that any repairs performed by another contractor will result in the closing of this case. Inspectors must be able to visibly inspect violations and photographs will not be accepted for inspection services. **If you are experiencing severe leaking of a roof, or a life/safety situation involving heating or air conditioning, please call 505-476-4700 immediately.**

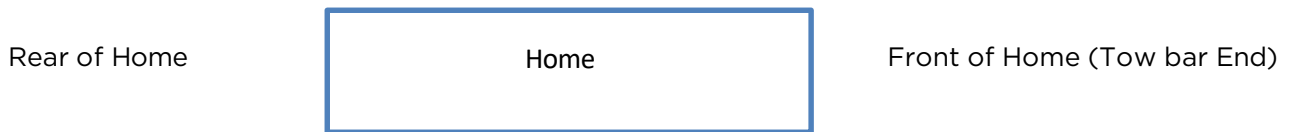
