INDUSTRY BULLETIN: 25-11

Emergency Hemp Rule Issued by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), Effective August 1, 2025

The Cannabis Control Division (CCD) is notifying licensees that the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has issued an emergency amendment to 20.10.2 NMAC, effective August 1, 2025, governing hemp extraction, manufacturing, and warehouse facilities. This rule impacts cannabis manufacturers using hemp-derived ingredients in their products pursuant to the Hemp Manufacturing Act and includes restrictions related to cannabinoid synthesis and hemp material sourcing.

To support industry understanding and compliance, NMED's Cannabis and Hemp Bureau (CHB) will host a virtual training on **Wednesday, August 6, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** via Zoom. The training will cover key rule changes and provide an opportunity for licensees to ask questions.
